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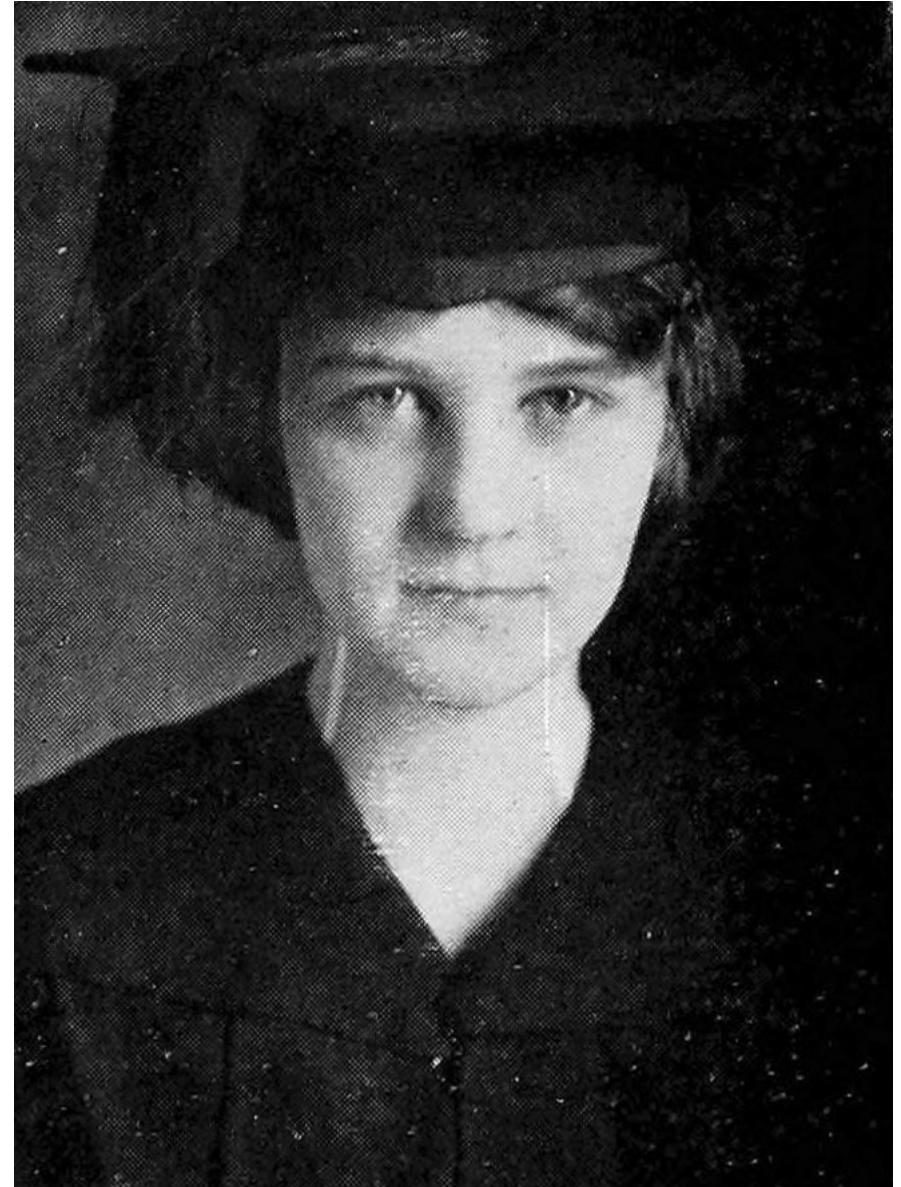
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The Aisteach Foundation is the home of Ireland's avant-garde archive.
